Family-Centered Services

This program establishes positive, long-term support by introducing families to available resources within the community. Family-Centered Services offer family assessments, goal planning and individual services.

Services include:

- Home, community and school-based services
- Parenting and homemaking help
- Mental health education
- Daily living training
- Case management
- A referral to individual, group or family therapy
- Collaboration of services with schools and at home

Child Advocacy Center

The Child Advocacy Center (CAC) is a regional center located at the Suzanne Gresham Center where interviews and investigations of children who have experienced abuse are conducted in a concise manner. The CAC allows the community law enforcement and legal teams to pursue reports of child abuse more effectively and efficiently, resulting in higher prosecution rates. Most importantly, the CAC offers protection in a nurturing and healing environment for victims of child abuse.

FosterHope

A specialized foster care program and private adoption program are available for children who are in need of emotional or mental health support. It is a therapeutic program that recruits, trains and licenses new foster families within Indiana.

Meridian Health Pediatrics

Meridian also offers specialized pediatric care for children. Meridian Health Pediatrics clinics are available at several locations, including pediatric urgent care.



Services include:

- Referrals and collaboration with specialists

Meridian School Clinics

School-based health clinics are a collaborative partnership with Meridian Health Services and community schools offering a medical and behavioral clinic within the school-setting to help teachers and families have convenient, instant access to immediate whole-person care.



Adolescent Substance Use Treatment

An outpatient program is available specifically for teens dealing with substance use issues.

- Offers treatment with the goal of abstinence
- Includes a substance use assessment

Counseling

Meridian offers professional counseling by licensed clinical social workers, mental health counselors, and therapists for children, teens and families. Providers use multiple methods to treat a number of concerns including depression, anxiety, conduct, ADHD, PTSD among other life challenges.

Psychiatric Services

This program includes individual psychiatric evaluations, medication evaluations and follow up with treatment of psychiatric issues as part of comprehensive treatment. Counselors work with children and their families to solve problems and find solutions. Medications may be prescribed by a psychiatrist or clinical nurse specialist to help relieve symptoms.

Intensive Wraparound Services

This is a high-level service designed to help families avoid residential placement of a child, or facilitate a child's quicker release from residential placement.

- Identifies the emotional and psychological needs of the child and family
- Services can include crisis and family counseling, training and support, respite care and substance use care

Emergency Services

This service is available to children and teens suffering from an emergency psychiatric situation. If you are in need of immediate help call **800-333-2647**.
