Residential Group Homes

Meridian's residential group homes provide a communitybased living alternative for people with mental illness and addictions. The homelike environment helps residents experience life in a family atmosphere, with a caring and supportive foundation provided by trained and loving staff.

Programs help residents focus on retaining, maintaining and learning daily living skills. The living arrangement includes housing, meals, help with activities of daily living and financial management. Residents assist and prepare meals for the house and are also involved in meal planning and grocery shopping.

Planned activities promote independence and mobility. These planned activities include trips to restaurants, shopping, and social outings.

We understand each person is an individual with unique needs and preferences. Meridian's group home staff provides compassionate support and encouragement to the residents they serve, so they can continue challenging themselves and pursue active lifestyles.

Meridian currently has seven group homes located in Muncie, New Castle and Richmond. Five of the group homes are co-ed and one is a male only residence. The Women's Recovery Home is a female only residence.

Women's Recovery Home



Meridian's first substance use disorder recovery home for women in Muncie. This 2-Phase structured behavioral health treatment program uses a holistic approach in treating the mind and body in a residential group homesetting to help



women overcome their struggle with substance use disorder.

Women's Recovery Home is a structured setting in order to provide optimal care:

- Typically a 30–90 day period stay for women, and their children (when applicable).
- Duration of stay is dependent upon patient's individualized treatment plan.

Patients are engaged in both individual & group therapy.

Integrated services with other Meridian divisions may include:

- Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)
- Intensive Outpatient Treatment (IOT)
- Maternal Treatment Program (MTP)
- Women's Health—OB/GYN
- Primary Medical Care
- Pediatric Care (for their dependent children)

Qualifying individuals seeking a group home residence must have a Medicaid Rehabilitation Option (MRO) package. Individuals seeking a group home residence must also have Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI).
