

What is Supported Employment?

The Supported Employment program provides competitive work opportunities in an integrated work setting. Our services include:

- Job Readiness
- Job Coaching
- Job Searching
- Job Retention

Linkage to Vocational Rehabilitation services.

The program is committed to helping individuals shift from a dependence on state and federal assistance to a more independent and socially integrated job market.

Benefit Information Network (BIN)

We provide certified BIN professionals who have been trained in and have knowledge of federal, state, and local benefits and work incentives.

BIN liaisons understand the impact of income on long-term supports and services and can advise workers and families on how best to maintain employment while building more financial independence.

Pre-Emplolyment Transition Services for Students (Pre-ETS)

Pre-Employment Transition Services is a program to assist students in preparing for post-secondary education or the work world. Services are coordinated with the student's current in-school classes and academic track.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Job exploration counselling
- Work-based learning experiences
- Counselling on opportunities for enrollment in post secondary education
- Workplace readiness
- Instruction in self-advocacy

Pre-ETS is currently available in Delaware County only.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Pre-ETS is offered at no cost to students who meet the following requirements:

- Between the Ages of 14-22 years old
- Enrolled in high school, post-secondary or other recognized education program
- Has a disability
- Eligible for and receiving special education or related services under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IEP, 504 plan)
