Our Purpose

Meridian Health Services supports children and their families beyond traditional office settings to offer the highest quality care and treatment in a child's living environment, which includes at home, school and community.

From intensive home-based treatments and group therapies to school-based programs, our team provides a broad range of services to support at-risk youth with the tools, treatment and resources to thrive. Meridian's unique partnership with nearly 300 schools in Indiana helps to provide intensive services within the schools to collaborate together for the best outcomes for children.



Behavioral Health

School: At school, the behavioral clinician works with the child to address any behavioral or emotional issues by helping the child develop and utilize new skills.

Home: Behavioral clinicians also work with the child's family by engaging them in the treatment process. They can provide parents or guardians with tools to help promote positive behaviors.

Community: In order to work on specific goals and skills, behavioral clinicians may work with the child in a community setting such as a library, playground, park, etc.

Treatment is a year-round service and continues through all school breaks.

Medical Services

Meridian Health Services offers primary medical care including physicals, vaccines, visits due to illness, as well as the treatment of chronic medical conditions.

Medical Services are offered at various office locations, including MeridianMD, Meridian Dental— Family Dentistry, Meridian School Clinics, Meridian Health Pediatrics and the Suzanne Gresham Center.



Psychiatric Services

Meridian Health Services also offers psychiatric services. This may include complete psychiatric evaluations as well as medication management.

Therapists

Like behavioral clinicians, therapists may work with a child in the school, home and community settings and may consist of weekly individual and/or family therapy. Therapists also collaborate with other Meridian service providers to provide comprehensive treatment.
